

# Garden Rose Wedding Variety Guide





### **Pink O'Hara**

This is a light pink rose with all the characteristics of a garden rose plus terrific performance in the vase: great fragrance, quartered center, and a large head. As if that weren't enough, it has a superior vase life! For event work, you need to put in flower food 4-5 days before the event to get 80% open blooms.



### **Aphrodite**

This is a rounded deep cupped, light pink rose with a slight fragrance that is naturally soft and romantic. Volumes are low, so please order with plenty of lead time. Aphrodite only needs 2-3 days to open fully.



### **Augusta Luise**

A favorite in the United Kingdom, this is light pink rose has a deeper pink, almost peach center. It has wavy petals that open and comes with side shoots. The fragrance is strong and the vase life is good. This is a very Romantic rose. Augusta needs 3-4 days in water to open nicely.



### **Marietheresia**

This is a medium pink rose that will open up into a delightful large rosette shape. It has no fragrance but makes up for it with its Old English Garden shape. Although it has a 7-10 day vase life, it needs to be in water 3-4 days before the event to be at 80% open.



### **Romantic Antike**

This is a cabbage rose, like the ones painted by Dutch masters in the 19th century. It carries a slight fragrance, and opens up into a large, petal rich rose. It has a dirty pink color and will reach a good point of openness after 3-4 days in the vase.



### **Yves Piaget**

This showy pink rose is the original Peony rose. It has a peony shape, a terrific, strong rose fragrance, and is very large headed. Will please any bride! Its vase life is 5 – 6 days only. Recommended for event work only. You can use it after 2-3 days in water.



### **Pink Piano**

This is a round, deep cup shaped rose with a striking medium pink color. It is cut with side shoots. Pink Piano will open up perhaps 70%, has a long vase life (10-12 days) and no fragrance. It needs 5-6 days in water before it opens.



### **Baronesse**

This is the sister of Mariatheresia. They have the same Old English garden rosette shape and open up flat. Baronesse is quite darker, a bit more wild. No fragrance, needs about 3-4 days in water to be at the right point of cut for an event



### **Alabaster**

A fabulous white rose, alabaster will open to a perfect rosette shape, maintain its hard petals throughout its life, has a great fragrance, and a terrific vase life. Alabaster has a slightly buttery center and needs 3-4 days in water to open nicely.



### **White O'Hara**

Is a terrific white rose: it has a large head size, does not get damaged in transit, has a tremendous floral fragrance, and opens up to 4 hearts. Its color is a bit tricky since it changes as it opens. Starts off with an ivory center but ends up quite white. It will need 4-5 days in water before it can be used.



### **Vitality**

This is the most fragrant of all our white roses! Its scalloped petals give it a garden, romantic look. Its vase life is good. This is rose can be quite butter yellow when there are overcast days. Needs 3-4 days in water before use.



### **Mythos**

This is a very hardy rose. It is an ivory color, has a hybrid tea rose shape and does not have a fragrance. It will however last a long time in a vase (10-12 days). It will need 4-5 days in water but won't open up more than this photo shows.



### **Jeanne Moreau**

This French Garden Rose is very fragrant, very delicate and the color of vanilla ice cream. It has a large head and as it opens will show its quartered center. This is a very fragrant rose! But it is delicate and needs to be cared for. It requires 4-5 days in water before use.



### **Caramel Antike**

This is a German rose. The sister of Romantic Antike. It has a large head, and will open like a cabbage rose, similar to those painted by the Dutch masters in the 19th century. It has a slight fragrance and good vase life. Caramel requires 4-5 days in water before it can be used.



### **Piano**

This is a round, deep cup shaped rose with a dark red color. It is cut with side shoots. Piano will open up perhaps 70%, has a long vase life 10-12 days) and no fragrance. Only for bold brides who dare marry with red! Needs 4-5 days in water before use.
