

SUNFLOWERS – FALL 2011





Yellow Sunflowers

Sunflowers are known for their large, solitary blossom. Yellow Sunflowers are composed of cheery yellow ray petals surrounding a deep brown center.



Teddy Bear

The fluffy Teddy Bear has blooms that are big, double, and fluffy unlike the standard sunflower that has one ring of petals around the outside.



Mahogany

Blazing bicolor blooms are formed with golden petal edges and a molten burgundy ring surrounding a brown center.



Green Center

Colorful green center surrounded by bright yellow petals.



Chocolate

The petals of the Chocolate Sunflower are a rich burgundy-brown on the front surrounding a dark rich brown center.



Ring of Fire

A very different Sunflower. Ring of Fire Sunflower has bi-colored petals with a dark red base and golden yellow tips surrounding a chocolate brown center.



Sunbeam

The Sunbeam Sunflower has a uniquely bright center which starts out bright green and turns yellow as the flower matures.



Tinted Red

The dark centers of Red Sunflowers are surrounded by glorious warm orange-red petals that are yellow at the base.



Starburst Panache

Golden yellow double petalled blooms form a halo around rich, green bronze-brown centers.

Flower Information

Availability: Year round

Vase Life: Approximately 10 days

Characteristics:

These are exceptional cut flowers with long stems, lasting up to 10 days in the vase. The Sunflowers large flower and long stems make them the perfect addition for tall arrangements.

Flower Care & Handling:

With the proper care and handling, flower vase life can increase and enable flowers to take on a better appearance.

- Make underwater cuts to the bottom of each stem. Trim approximately half an inch with a sharp knife, not scissors.
- Remove any foliage that may fall below the water line.
- Place flowers in a clean container with water and flower preservative.
- Containers should be refilled with fresh water every other day.
- Keep flowers in a cool environment. Sunflowers may be kept at cooler temperatures, down to 40F.
- Do not store Sunflowers near fruit as ethylene gas can prematurely wilt and fill the flowers.
